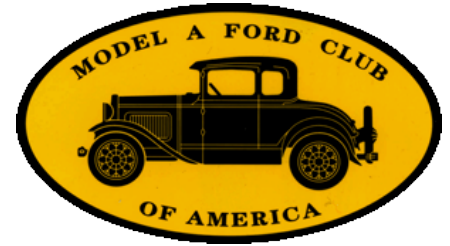


This is a nice 1935 Ford that stopped by our Model A meeting. We had 7 cars from the membership show up. **What a treat!**
