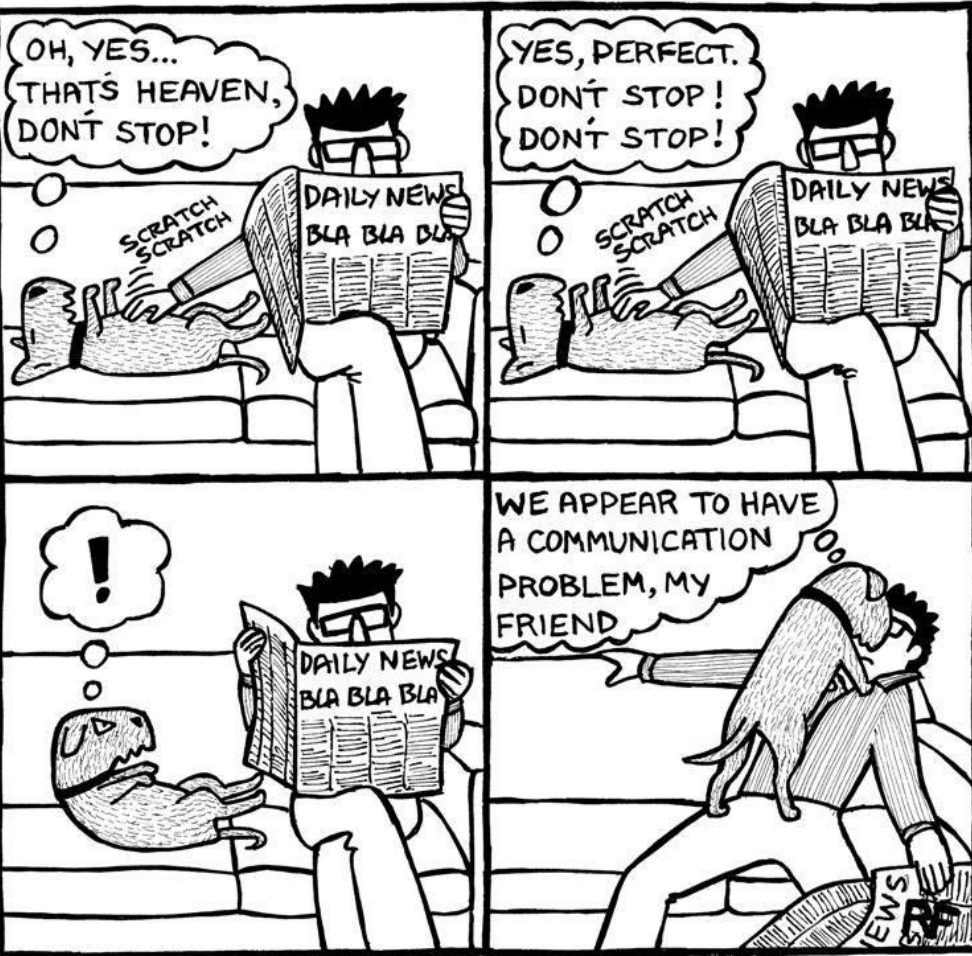

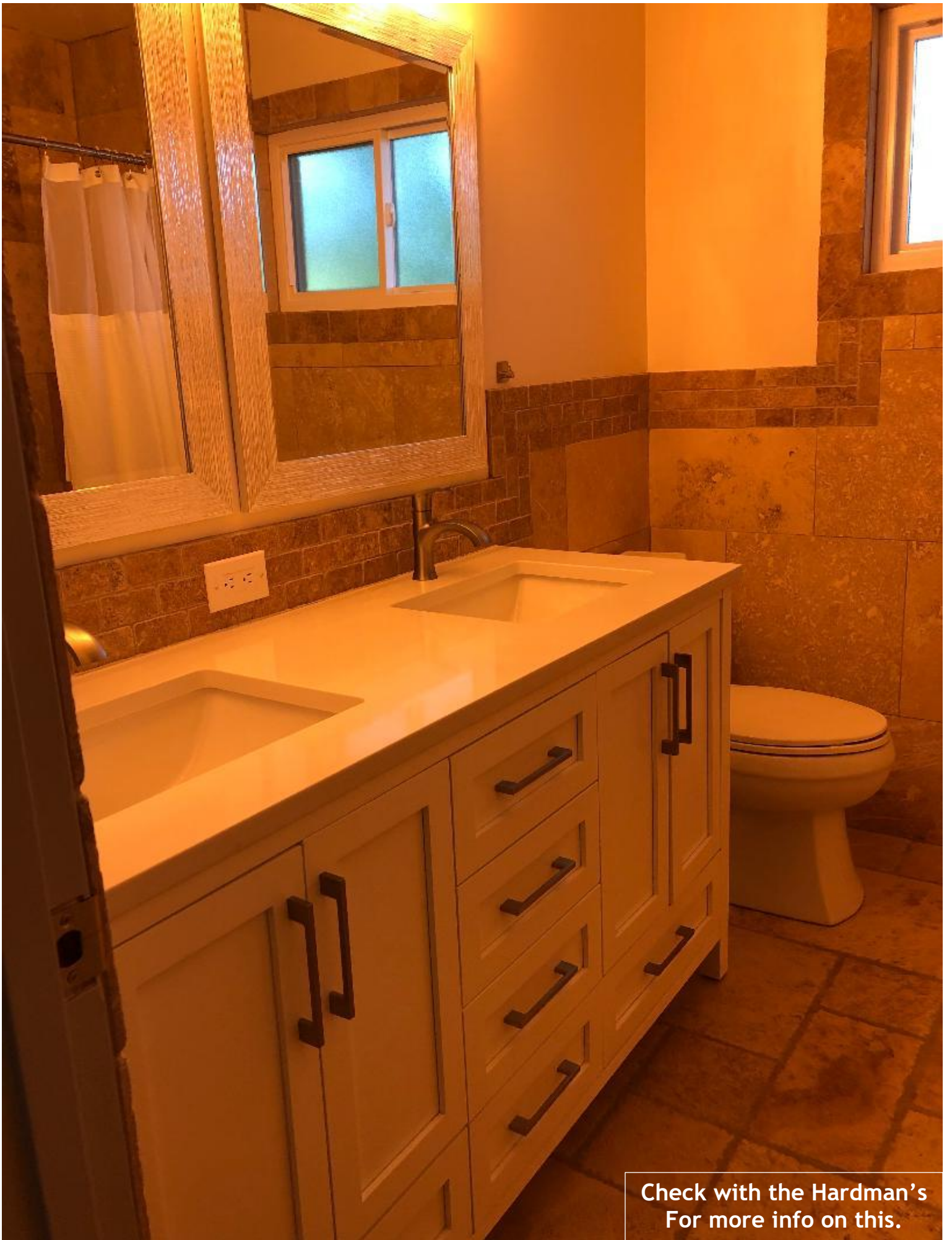
Henry & Edsel Ford with the new Model A Ford



Blue Ice While this photo looks photoshopped, it's actually real. It may look like a tsunami was flash-frozen, but actually, the photographer here captured a phenomenon known as blue ice, which is when falling snow gets so packed on a glacier it eventually becomes part of the glacier. The reason it is blue is that the ice absorbs lower light frequencies while reflecting the higher ones. This means that red, orange, yellow, and green get absorbed, but blue and violet are reflected.

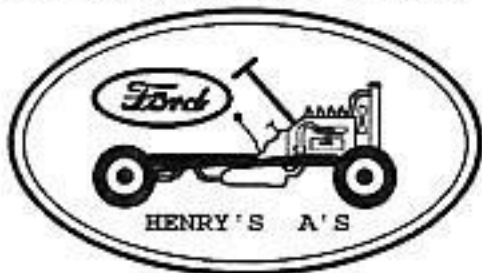

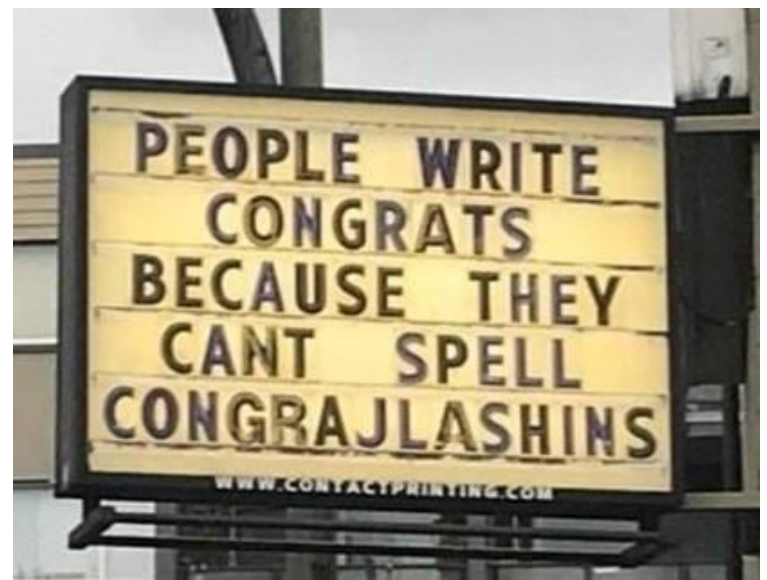

Lost Lighthouse
