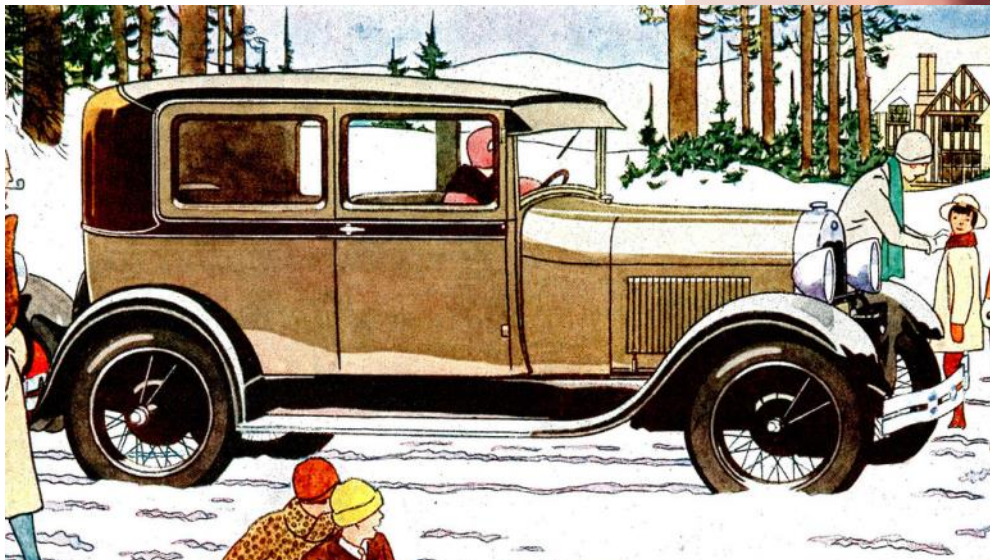
President's Corner
