He's included a few photos of the exterior and interior as well as the motor after rebuild.

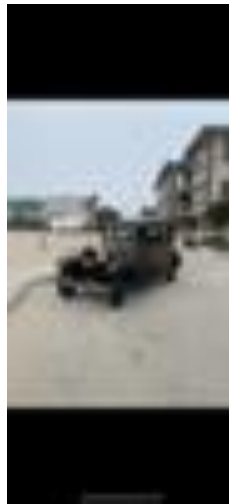
