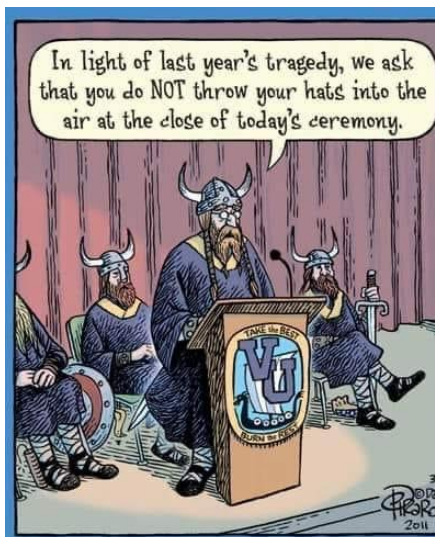

Hotel Update Information 3/7/2025: The Good , The Bad, and the Great News!



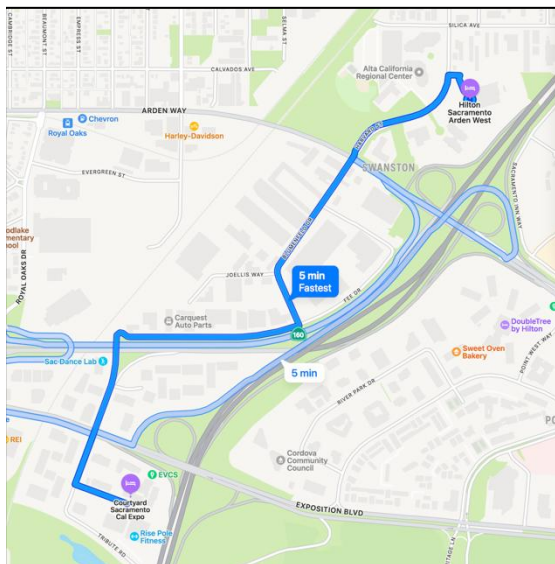
The Good: We have filled our block of rooms contracted for the Hilton Arden Sacramento, so contractually, this is good.

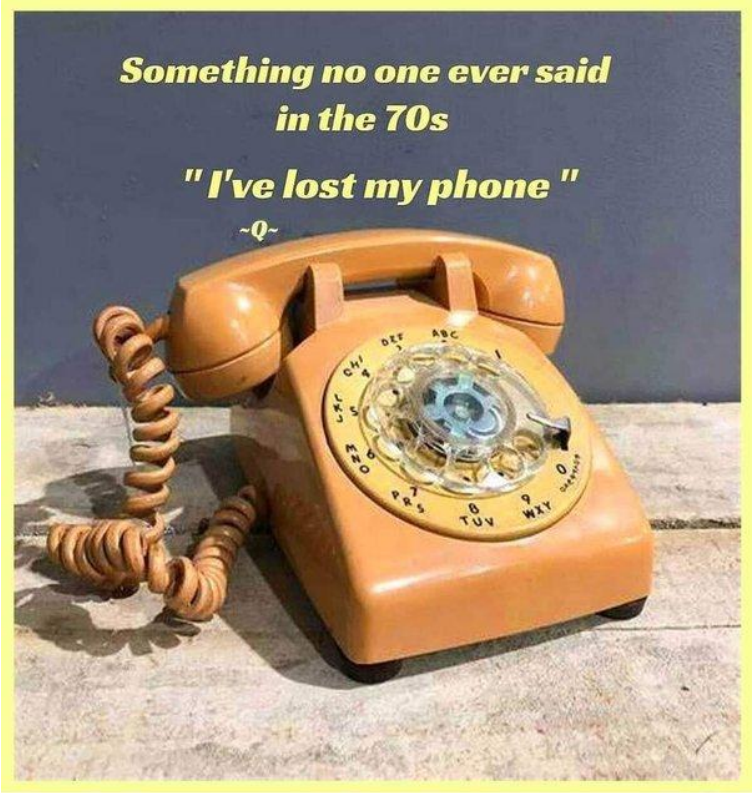

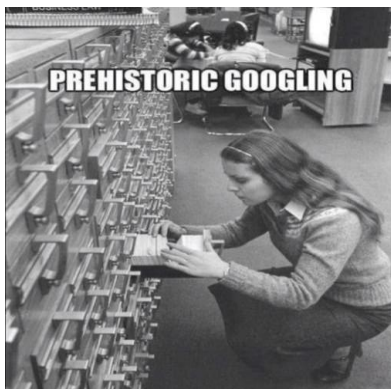
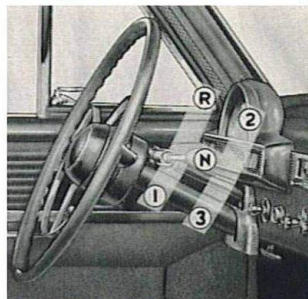
